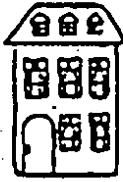

THE AFTER SCHOOL WORKSHOP, now approaching its 22nd year right here, offers a wide range of activities for elementary school children.

All take place every day right here on-site. Students develop skills and work on projects that engage their interest in a warm, low-key, supportive environment.

The Workshop has a unique "penthouse" setting here.

In addition to indoor facilities, children enjoy exclusive use of a spacious terrace, a beautiful play area with climbing bars set on special surfacing, picnic tables and shade trees overhanging its fence.

The everyday Workshop program includes teacher-supervised individual homework help, hands-on computers, arts & crafts, etc. Specialized classes are also offered including Tennis, Hip Hop, Martial Arts, Foreign Languages, Improv Acting, Minecraft, Dramatics, 3-D Printing, Robotics and more. These classes are open to all students.

NOTE RE COSTS: Students attending the Workshop on the day they attend a class will receive a discount on the cost of their classes.

The Workshop provides the opportunity for children to socialize informally under the guidance of a professional staff. Children of different ages with similar interests have opportunities to work and play together.

A staff of dedicated teachers is headed by Sheila N. Bandman, M.A. Sarah Lawrence College. She studied at The Harvard School of Education and participated in a special program conducted by Anna Freud in London. She also taught Developmental Reading at The Nightingale Bamford School.

The After School Workshop on Madison, Inc. is licensed by The New York City Board of Health and is a New York State Registered Program. Hours are 2:35 pm to 6:00 pm. (we open early on Early Dismissal days). Fees are moderate. Students may enroll from one to five days a week, or register only for a class.
